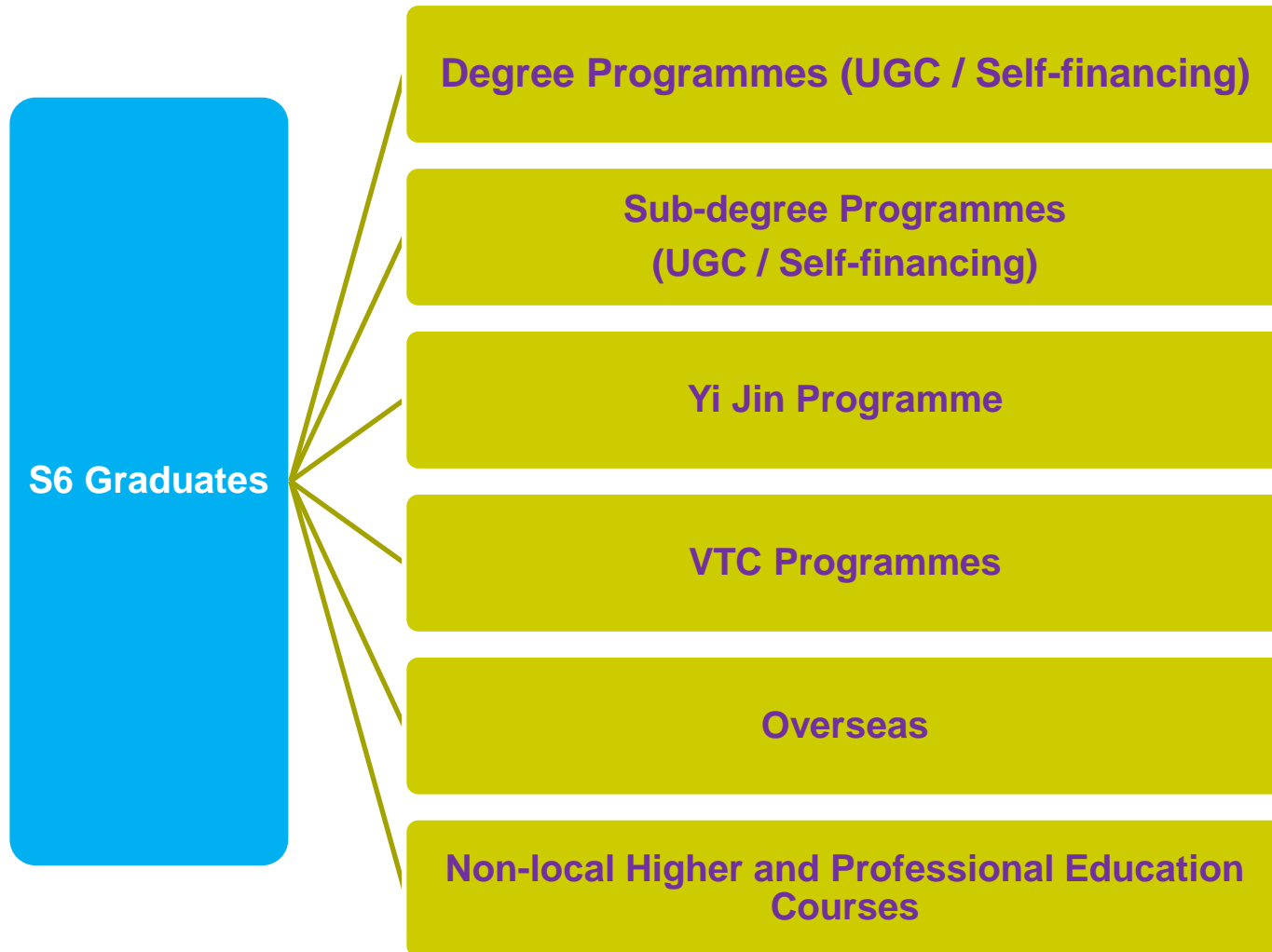

E-APP (Electronic Advance Application System for Post-secondary Programmes)



- It is developed HKDSE candidates to lodge advance applications for locally-accredited sub-degree and bachelor degree programmes not covered by JUPAS before announcement of public examination results.

Studying in UK

- UK undergraduate courses have a duration of 3 years (4 years in Scotland), 4 years (Engineering) or 5-6 years (Medicine, Architecture & Dentistry)

Studying in UK

Entrance Requirements (Bachelor)



- 3 Subjects getting Level 5,4,4 in HKDSE
- Generally 6.0 – 6.5 in IELTS
- Some may required 7.0 in IELTS(e.g. Law, Medicine)

Studying in UK



- UCAS (Universities and Colleges Admission Service) is the national body through which applications are processed for entry to full-time higher education courses (over 50,000 courses at 391 universities/colleges) in UK.

Application deadlines

- Depending on the subject and on the university
- Mid-October deadline: medicine, dentistry and veterinary science courses and anyone applying to Oxford and Cambridge
- Mid-January deadline: The majority

Studying in USA



- 2 pathways to get a bachelor's degree in the USA:
 - Earn a degree by attending a 4-year college/ university or
 - First attending a 2-year community college and then transferring to a 4-year university/ college to complete the third and fourth year undergraduate program.

Studying in USA

Entrance Requirements (4 years Bachelor)



- Complete S6
- Prepare your transcript, TOEFL iBT or IELTS result.
- Finish SAT (Scholastic Assessment Test) or ACT (American College Testing)
- Prepare reference letter and Admission Essay
- Prove your financial status (1 year school fee and living expense)

Studying in USA



- Students may apply to as many as USA colleges/ universities as they want.
- Usually, students will be advised to select **3 to 5** colleges/ universities. (at least 12 months in advance).
- Check school's **admission requirements** and take **required tests**.
- Complete application forms **online**.
- Upon acceptance, apply for a student visa.
